I honestly cannot believe that the Festive Season is here — there has been so much uncertainty, so much loss (financially and emotionally) and so much sadness this year for everyone, that it feels a bit unreal that it is all hopefully going to come to an end. I truly pray that 2021 brings peace and prosperity for all. If you and your family are travelling this Festive Season, please drive carefully. If your pets are going to a Kennel or Cattery, please make sure that you protect them against external parasites (ticks and fleas) and make sure that their vaccines are up to date — dogs needs to have a Kennel Cough vaccine done and cats need to have a BB vaccine done in addition to their annual vaccination.

For everyone's safety, please remember to sanitise your hands before entering the Practice and you must still wear a mask. People not wearing a mask will be asked to leave.

If you are planning on getting a new pet for Christmas, please remember that the novelty of a puppy or kitten quickly wears off, especially if given to a young child. When you adopt or buy a new pet, you are essentially making a 12 to 15 year commitment. You need to do research before getting your new pet so that you are prepared to deal with any specific requirements or issues that certain breeds have. Never leave a puppy or kitten unsupervised with a young child.

As we are closed from the 25^{th} December 2020 until the 3^{rd} January 2021, please make sure that you have enough of your pet's food as well as their chronic medication to last until we open again on the 4^{th} January 2021.
