Sadly, Parvo (Catflu) is rearing its ugly head again so please, if you have a new puppy, take advantage of this month's focus at the Practice, and get your puppy vaccinated. Do not take your puppy to other social places until they have had all 3 of their puppy vaccinations as the risk of them getting exposed to this virus is extremely high. Your puppy needs to get vaccinated from 6 weeks of age. There should be 3 to 4 weeks in between each vaccination.

I am so thankful for the rain that has fallen but with this, ticks and fleas are becoming a problem. Ensure that you are applying or dosing an effective product to your pet as per the guidelines for that specific product. Please make sure that you only apply or dose dog specific products to your dog and cat specific products to your cat. Please remember that dog specific products can kill your cat.

Unfortunately, as with most companies and practices at the beginning of the year, we have had to have a price increase. The new pricing will take effect as of the 1 January 2020.
