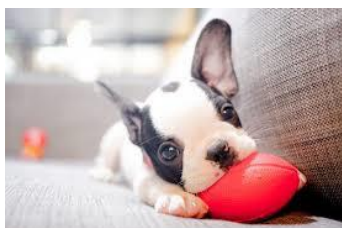

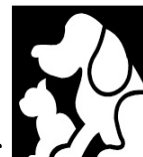

**Keep your Pets Safe!**

Unfortunately, over the past few weeks, the number of pets in Edenvale and the surrounding areas, that have gone missing, has escalated. It has escalated to such a degree that it is suspected that a syndicate is involved in stealing these pets. Cats and dogs have gone missing.

It is difficult to keep cats inside your property without having to adjust your walling or building a cattery so that they cannot jump over the wall or slip through your gate. Dogs are a lot easier to keep inside your property but ensure that they are kept away from your front garden, especially small dogs, as they can be easily taken through or over the fence or wall. Ensure that your pets are microchipped so that you can be contacted if they are found and taken to the closest vet or rescue centre.

If you see people looking into other people's gardens/properties or if you see someone taking a cat or a dog and they look suspicious, report them to your security company, local community watch or the police. Take down as much information as possible – the number plate, description of the person or people that you have seen and the street address. Be vigilant and keep your pets safe.
